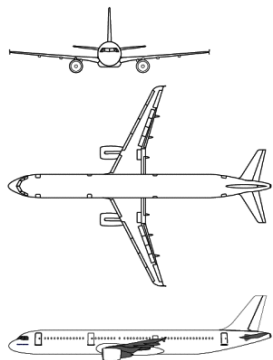


A321-232 RESTORATION, NEW DELHI, INDIA

The aircraft was ferried 13,000 miles without incident.
